Dear brothers, greetings in the grace of Christ,



By starting this year we felt it would be a different year with challenges that ask much of our attention, search and dependence on God. We got here at Project AMI (an indigenous training school) 17 ethnic groups coming from different states of Brazil in order to face daily new things besides struggle with the national language. We notice that some were not even converted but as the days go by they began to understand that the Christian life is good that makes much difference and three of those who were not saved publicly accepted Christ clearly demonstrating their commitment to follow Christ. Praise the Lord!!!

Another challenge was to consolidate the project SEMERAITA in Iranduba AM where we will have one of the largest training schools for indigenous people in South America on an estate of 114 hc on the shores of the Solimões river, acquired by CONPLEI in 2009. We started with a group of 70 brothers coming from two churches in the U.S. and three Brazilian churches coming from Manaus for a total of 100 brothers, It was a blessing to see how God guided supplying every detail for the beginning of this great project.



This year our family is complete. Our daughter was away for three years studying at Word of Life seminary Atibaia but now she is with us helping in the tasks we have with the AMI school and with CONPLEI. She plans to study Anthropology and for a few months go to England as an exchange student to improve her English.

We made several trips within Brazil and abroad as a speaker at conferences challenging the people of God in a continuous and firm responsibility in cross-cultural mission. Although very slow, we have seen

a moving in that direction.
